Purple Hands is a low input, purity-driven winery. Our Chardonnay is barrel fermented, and aged on the lees for one year. It goes through full malolactic fermentation.

Latchkey Vineyard—an estate vineyard—is situated at 500 feet on a southern aspect in the Dundee Hills of Oregon’s Willamette Valley. Planted mainly to Pinot Noir from the Pommard family as well as Chardonnay, the vineyard spans 11 acres that stretch from the top of the hill down to the road below. It sits directly South of Haakon/Lenai Vineyard.
