



# Haakon/Lenai Vineyard Pinot Noir

## Winemaking

Purple Hands is a low input, purity-driven winery. Ferments are a mixture of techniques: Pied de Cuve, native yeasts, and some commercial strains as needed. Whole cluster and skin macerations are vintage-dependent styles. Wines are bottled unfinned and unfiltered to retain the honesty of the vineyard.
