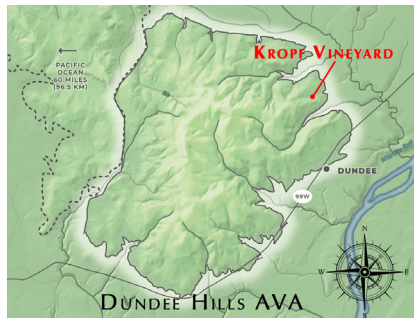


Kropf Vineyard Pinot Noir 2022



The Vineyard

This two-acre vineyard consists of the Pinot Noir clone Dijon 115, and 100 percent, well-drained, alluvial Jory soil that formed from basalt rock sediment. Vineyard Owners Jody and Michelle Kropf own and operate Red Hills Market in downtown Dundee, Oregon.

Winemaking

Purple Hands is a low intervention, purity-driven winery. Ferments are a mixture of techniques: native yeasts, and some commercial strains as needed. 20% whole cluster for 2022. Skin macerations are vintage-dependent styles. Wines are bottled unfiltered and unfiltered to retain the honesty of the vineyard and the vintage.
