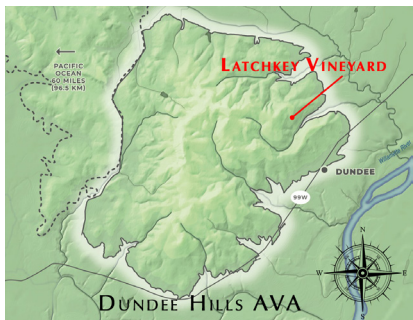


# Latchkey Vineyard Pinot Noir 2022



## The Vineyard

Latchkey Vineyard is situated at 500 feet on a southern aspect in the Dundee Hills of Oregon's Willamette Valley. Planted mainly to Pinot Noir from the Pommard family as well as Chardonnay, the vineyard spans 13 acres that stretch from the top of the hill down to the road below. It sits directly South of Haakon/Lenai Vineyard.

**Appellation:** Dundee Hills

**Grape Varietal:** 100% Pinot Noir

**Clones:** Pommard

**Soil:** Jory (Volcanic)

**Elevation:** 500 feet

**Aspect:** Southeast

**Year Planted:** 2006

**Farming Practices:** Dry farmed, organically farmed, not certified.

**Ageing:** 10 months in 30% New French Oak

**Ageability:** Up to 10+ years

**Alcohol:** 13.5%

**pH:** 3.70

**Production:** 672 cases



## Winemaking

Purple Hands is a low intervention, purity-driven winery. Ferments are a mixture of techniques: native yeasts, and some commercial strains as needed. 20% whole cluster for 2022. Skin macerations are vintage-dependent styles. Wines are bottled unfinned and unfiltered to retain the honesty of the vineyard and the vintage.
