The Vineyard

West Wind Vineyard—an estate vineyard—is situated in the middle of Ribbon Ridge at 400-600ft elevation. Originally blackberries & shrubs, Cody & Marque Wright planted the first 6 acres of Pinot Noir in Fall 2017, and 8 more acres of Pinot Noir in Fall 2019. Organically farmed, planted with Pommard, Dijon (777, 115, 943) & Wädenswil on Willakenzie soil.

Skin macerations are vintage-dependent styles. Wines are bottled unfined and unfiltered to retain the honesty of the vineyard and the vintage.
